**RE: RECOMMEND MODIFICATIONS TO VDOT'S PROPOSED NEABSCO GREENWAY DESIGN AT INTERSTATE 95**

**ACTION:**

**WHEREAS**, the Prince William County Trails and Blueways Council has been briefed on the proposed Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) revised improvements to the Interstate 95 bridge over Neabsco Creek (as attached) in Prince William County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Neabsco Creek Greenway has been included in the Comprehensive Plan for many years and will pass under Interstate 95; and

**WHEREAS**, VDOT has proposed a design that will limit the Neabsco Creek Greenway at this location to a 5' wide path which is further limited by a concave overhanging structure thus obstructing the path's vertical clearance and would be dangerous to the users of the Greenway; and

**WHEREAS**, once constructed, modification or redesign of the path and structure will be cost prohibitive;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Prince William County Trails and Blueways Council strongly urges that the Prince William Board of County Supervisors convey these concerns to VDOT, and urges that the VDOT design meet VDOT shared use path standards to adequately serve the users of the Neabsco Creek Greenway, including at a minimum a 10' wide surface with railings and lighting for safety purposes, and further that the design accommodates fish and other wildlife that will use the Neabsco Creek riparian area to cross under Interstate 95.
